Rule 26(f): This is the meet and confer rule. This rule requires all parties to meet within 99 days of the lawsuit's filing and at least 21 days before a scheduled conference. Rule 26(g): Requires an attorney to sign every e-discovery request, response, or objection.

E-Discovery Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Federal ...

Every disclosure under Rule 26 (a) (1) or (a) (3) and every discovery request, response, or objection must be signed by at least one attorney of record in the attorney's own name—or by the party personally, if unrepresented—and must state the signer's address, e-mail address, and telephone number.

L. Supplementation of Discovery Reponses. Tennessee rule 26.05, as clarified in the 2001 comment, requires that deposition answers of all witnesses be supplemented. Federal rule 26(e) addresses only the depositions of experts. Both rules require supplementation of answers to interrogatories and responses to requests for production of documents.
