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Massachusetts Home Health Aide Exam

In order to receive your home health aide certificate in Massachusetts you need to follow the minimum [federal] home health aide education requirements. HHA training programs must consist of: at least seventy-five (75) hours of training. which needs to include at least sixteen (16) hours of clinical training.

Massachusetts HHA Requirements - How to be a Home Health Aide

Requirements for CNA and HHA Certification. In the state of MA, the American Red Cross is in charge of the "Nurse Assistant Home Health Aide" training programs. Their 75-hour training program runs for both types of aides. However, it stops there for HHAs who do not have recourse to state certification. They work as HHAs for non-medical home care agencies, assisting individuals in their homes.

Massachusetts CNAs take the Nurse Aide Competency Evaluation (NACE), administered by the American Red Cross (ARC). There are two components to the evaluation. The skills test involves scenarios; the candidate must act as a CNA and provide appropriate care. A candidate is expected to bring a person who can serve as an actor on the day of the test.

A home health aide is a person working for a home health agency or hospice that performs home health services ordered by a licensed physician, licensed chiropractor, licensed podiatrist, or

licensed optometrist. The home health aide must successfully complete a home health agency's competency evaluation.

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
